Merry Super Bowl everyone! For that percentage of you out there who won't make it into work tomorrow for the not yet official national holiday, do yourself a favor and read up on your Austin Deal Highlights! This week, more big news out of the consumer products sector, as snack brand **Beanitos**, who sold over 15 million bags of chips in 2018, was picked up by **The Good Bean!**

Austin Financing Activity

- [Wheel](#), a platform that connects practitioners with tele-health staffing opportunities, [raised](#) \$13.9M Series A led by **CRV** with participation from **Tusk Venture Partners** and **Silverton Partners**. Concurrent with its Series A raise, the company has rebranded from Enzyme Health to Wheel. The company has raised \$15.6M to date.
- [ArtCraft Entertainment](#), a local video game developer, [closed](#) \$11.7M Series A funding round in advance of releasing its new immersive game "[Crowfall](#)".
- [Genprex](#) (NASDAQ: GNPX), a clinical-stage gene therapy company that focuses on fighting cancer, [closed](#) its common stock offer for a total of \$8M. The company sold an aggregate of 7.6M shares at \$1.05 per share.
- [Stoplight](#), a developer of an online platform that helps developers build, test, and improve their web APIs, [raised](#) \$6M Series A co-led by previous investors **Next Coast Ventures** and **Bill Wood Ventures**. The company has raised \$10M to date.
- [Grid4C](#), a provider of AI and machine learning solutions for the energy industry, raised \$6M of venture funding from **Alectra Utilities**, **Israel Cleantech Ventures** and **iAngels**. The company has raised approx. \$12.5M to date.
- [Vault](#), a student loan benefits platform, raised [\\$4.8M](#) of venture funding from undisclosed investors. The company has raised almost \$13M to date from investors including **Vestigo Ventures**, **CMFG Ventures**, and **Rubicon Venture Capital**.
- [Kronologic](#), an AI powered active scheduling platform, [raised](#) \$1M Pre-Seed funding led by **Geekdom Fund** with participation from **Trammell Venture Partners**, **Long View Technology Ventures**, **Stumberg Family fund**, **Complete Growth Investor**, and angel investors **Don Douglas**, **Justin Siegel**, and **Andrew Busey**.

Austin M&A Activity

- [Beanitos](#), a producer of bean chips, was [acquired](#) by [\[i\]The Good Bean](#). Exact terms of the deal were not disclosed but Beanitos investors, **L Catterton**, **2x Consumer Products Growth Partners**, and **BFY Capital** are now each minority shareholders in The Good Bean. The company had publicly disclosed approx. \$40M in funding to date.
- Austin-based **Mitratech**, a risk management software provider for enterprise legal management solutions, [acquired](#) **ClusterSeven**, a London-based data privacy firm. Financial terms were not disclosed. This is the company's ninth acquisition.

Other Relevant/Regional Deal Activity

- [OneDine](#), a Plano-based solutions provider for tableside ordering and payment, [raised](#) \$5M Series A at a post-money valuation of \$95M led by a private family trust. **TMW Capital** and **Hidden Lake Asset Management** participated in the round.
- [Capital Factory](#) is [expanding](#) in Houston by merging with **Station Houston** and partnering with **Rice University**. Station Houston launched in 2016 and currently includes more than 180 startups.

- **Proenza Venture**, a venture firm co-located in Houston and Monterrey, Mexico, closed on its first fund with \$50M in capital commitments. The fund will focus exclusively on mobility-focused startups.
- **PestRoutes**, a McKinney-based software provider for pest control companies, received a majority investment from PE firm **Gryphon Investors**. **Mainsail Partners** will maintain its minority stake. Financial terms were not disclosed.
- **Galvanize**, a Denver-based ed-tech program, has been acquired by **K12** (NYSE: LRN), a for-profit education company, for \$165M in cash. This deal includes the Galvanize campus in downtown Austin. **Galvanize** has raised over \$167.5M in funding over nine rounds.

Austin People

- **Cirrus Logic** (NASDAQ: CRUS) promoted **John Forsyth** to be the company's next president. Forsyth was previously Chief Strategy Officer responsible for the product strategy for Cirrus' low-power chips.
- The **Baldridge Foundation**, a private-sector partner of the **U.S. Department of Commerce**, awarded the 2020 Leadership Excellence Award in cybersecurity to **Mac McMillian**, founder of **CynergisTek** (NYSE: CTEK), a leader in healthcare cybersecurity, privacy, and compliance.

Austin (and other relevant) News

- A new health and medtech innovation district is expected to add \$800M in economic output and create 2,800 jobs according to a report recently commissioned by the Downtown Austin Alliance and Capital City Innovation.
- Houston Investors Close Third HALO Fund. **Texas Halo Fund** raised \$6 million for Halo III to invest in early stage businesses.
- 25 of Austin's Hottest Startups to Watch in 2020
- **Medici**, a local telemedicine platform simplifying interactions between doctors and patients, received one of the Business Intelligence Group's 2020 BIG Innovation Awards. This annual business awards program recognizes organizations, products, and people that are bringing new ideas to life in innovative ways.
- **UT** has another record year for sports revenue. It generated a record \$223.9 million in revenue during its 2018-19 fiscal year. Texas is one of the most lucrative college athletics departments in the country. Texas ranked No. 1 in 2017-18 for revenue among the nation's major college sports programs, ahead of No. 2 Texas A&M, which had almost \$212.4 million.
- Austin's **Superconductor Technologies** cutting staff as part of cost-reduction plan
- The **Michael and Susan Dell Foundation** pledged \$100M to students at The University of Texas for the next 10 years. Low-income freshmen students who are Pell Grant recipients will now receive an additional \$20K in financial aid.

- The average tech salary in Austin is higher than in any other Texas city, but the gap between Austin and Dallas and Houston is quickly shrinking.
