# Austin Weekly Deal Highlights

Happy SXSW! While you're taking stock on your overly ambitious weekend schedule that never had a chance, skim through this latest Austin Weekly Deal Highlights. This week, we saw **MAP Health** pull in a \$25M round from Aetna, and Arlo Gilbert launch his new venture **Osano** with a fresh \$3M equity round. Now get some sleep and charge your phone because we haven't even gotten into the crazies that come with SXSW Music and Film.

## **Austin Financing Activity**

- MAP Health Management, a platform to improve outcomes for patients treated for addictions, raised a \$25M Series A led by Aetna.
- <u>The Guild</u>, an Austin company that turns upscale apartments into tech-enabled hotel suites, raised an additional <u>\$7.5M</u> in funding to a previous round \$9M round led by **Maveron** last year.
- Osano, a data privacy and monitoring solution, <u>raised</u> a \$3M seed round led by LiveOak Venture Partners, and was joined by investors including Next Coast Ventures. Osano just launched <u>Privacy Monitor</u>, a free browser plugin and mobile app that helps users understand how websites, software vendors and other service providers treat their data privacy.
- <u>QuotaPath</u>, a sales commission tracking platform that operates out of Philadelphia and Austin, <u>raised</u> a \$3.5M funding round led by ATX Seed Ventures. The company has raised approx. \$5M to date.
- <u>VUV Analytics</u>, a developer of UV spectroscopy instruments to help companies analyze pharmaceuticals, raised <u>\$2.75M</u> of convertible debt. The company has raised over \$20M to date from investors including S3 Ventures and New Science Ventures.
- <u>High Brew Coffee</u>, a maker of cold brew coffees, <u>raised</u> an undisclosed amount of angel funding from **Halsey**, **Huston Street** and **Kings of Leon**. The company has raised over \$48M to date.
- <u>Claimbot</u>, a chatbot platform designed to simplify the process of claims management, <u>raised</u> a \$615k seed round from Social Starts, Notley Ventures and Google Assistant Investments program.

### **Austin M&A Activity**

- Abrigo, a technology provider of compliance, credit risk, and lending solutions for community financial institutions, <u>acquired</u> Wisconsin-based Farin Financial Risk Management, a leader in the enterprise risk management space, for an undisclosed amount. Abrigo is funded by private equity firm Accel-KKR.
- ATX Travel Tech, Austin's most popular travel technology Meetup group, has agreed to be <u>acquired</u> by the New York City-based travel startup community Voyager HQ.

• Springbox, a leading digital agency, has been <u>acquired</u> by **Prophet**, a global consulting firm that helps clients unlock uncommon growth, for an undisclosed amount.

## **Other Regional Deal Activity**

- <u>Alice</u>, a Houston-based digital community that connects women founders to resources tailored to their startup's needs, has
  received an undisclosed amount of funding from the **Bumble Fund**. The fund was launched last July by **Bumble**, a womenoriented dating app. The company previously raised a \$1.65M seed in February 2018.
- Boeing has <u>purchased</u> Houston-based ForeFlight, creator of a flight planning app that brought smartphones and tablets into the cockpit, for an undisclosed amount.
- <u>Pieces Tech</u>, a Dallas-based software provider that interprets patient data in real-time, raised <u>\$5M</u> in convertible debt from undisclosed investors. The company has raised over \$35M to date from investors including **Pacific Advantage Capital** and **Jump Capital**.

## **Austin People**

- Hypergiant Industries, who provides AI solutions, <u>hired</u> Brian Beard and Gary Gattis, as Global Chief Strategy and Legal Officer and General-Manager-in-Residence, respectively. Beard was most recently Managing Partner of Wilson Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati in Austin, and Gattis comes from Austin-based Spacetime Studios. Hypergiant last raised a \$5M Series A led by Align Capital in November.
- Infinitum Electric, which makes high-efficiency electric motors, has hired former GE executive Mark Preston as its COO. Most recently, he was VP of engineering at Array Technologies. The company announced a \$1.8M Series A from Cottonwood
   Technology Fund in January, and has raised \$2.7M to date.
- Ryan Merket, an early Facebook employee and angel investor, has joined Firebrand Ventures as a partner located in Austin. The firm, based out of Kansas City, invests in early-stage Midwest startups.
- MediaTech Ventures, strengthens its team with music + tech mogul Ted Cohen, as head of corporate development.
- Silverton Partners, an early stage VC firm, has hired former Capital Factory venture associate Kelsi Kamin.
