Austin Weekly Deal Highlights

I'm assuming most of you were talking about **Everlywell's** big \$50M raise over Easter brunch, so take this as a mere reminder. I subscribe to the belief that more you know about your health the better, and this company makes that data more accessible, by providing at-home health testing kits (from food sensitivities to high cholesterol). Also this week, **Imandra** pulling in \$5M for analyzing computer algorithms, and Austin ranking 2nd for most women owned startups.

Austin Financing Activity

- EverlyWell, a provider of at-home health testing kits, <u>raised</u> \$50M in funding led by long-time investors **Goodwater Capital** with **Highland Capital Partners** joining. **Next Coast Ventures**, **NextGen Venture Partners**, **SoGal Ventures** and others participated. The company has raised approx. \$60M to date.
- Imandra, a cloud native automated reasoning engine, <u>raised</u> \$5M in seed funding from **LiveOak Venture Partners**, **AlbionVC** and **IQ Capital**. The company, founded by UT alumni, is relocating its headquarters from London to Austin.
- Slingshot Aerospace, an advanced analytics company, <u>raised</u> \$5M in a seed funding led by ATX Venture Partners that included
 participation from Revolution's Rise of the Rest Seed Fund. The company has raised over \$8M to date.
- Locale, an Austin-based aparthotel—a serviced apartment complex that uses a hotel-style booking system, <u>raised</u> a \$2.5M seed round led by **Amplo and Susa Ventures**

Austin M&A Activity

Mastercard <u>acquired</u> Vyze, an Austin-based company that connects merchants with lenders to offer customers credit options
online and in-store. Financial terms weren't disclosed. Vyze had raised approximately \$47M in venture funding from investors
including Austin Ventures and Starvest Partners.

Other Regional Deal Activity

- <u>Innovapptive</u>, a Houston-based connected workforce platform for asset intensive industries, <u>raised</u> a \$16.3M Series A led by **Tiger Global Management**. The new funding brings the company's valuation to more than \$65M.
- Dallas-based retailer **Neiman Marcus** has <u>acquired</u> a minority stake in **Fashionphile**, an e-commerce startup focused on used luxury handbags and accessories

- Epsilon Data Management, an Irving-based provider of data-driven marketing technologies and services, and subsidiary of
 Alliance Data Systems (NYSE: ADS), has entered into a definitive agreement to be acquired by Publicis Group (PAR: PUB) for
 \$4.4B.
- TivaCloud, a Houston-based compliance management software company, was <u>acquired</u> by Fleetworthy Solutions, via its financial sponsors First Analysis and The Argentum Group, for an undisclosed amount.
- Nesh, a Houston-based developer of a smart assistant for oil and gas companies, announced a seed investment from Equinor
 Technology Ventures and Aristos Ventures in Dallas

Austin People

- Machine learning software developer Anaconda has <u>named</u> Ken Hoffman, the former Vice President of Emerging Technologies at Red Hat, to serve as both Chief Revenue Officer and Senior Vice President of Marketing. Anaconda has raised approx. \$53M to date from investors including BuildGroup and Citi Ventures.
- Arrive Logistics, a freight brokerage platform, <u>named</u> Richard Shields as chief financial officer and Michael Senftleber as
 executive vice president of product. Shields previously spent nearly three years as CFO of Yeti and Senftleber previously led the
 product team at software maker Spredfast. The company raised a \$10M Series A from Lead Edge Capital last June.
- Cipherloc Corporation (OTCQB: CLOK), a data security solutions company, <u>named</u> James Sullivan as Chief Financial Officer.
 He has previously served as CFO of two Nasdaq-listed companies: MoSys Inc., a provider of semiconductor solutions, and 8x8,
 Inc., a provider of Cloud-based unified communications as a service and contact center solutions.

Austin News

- Austin ranks No. 2 in the nation for most women-owned startups
- eRelevance, an online marketing platform targeted at healthcare providers and the mortgage industry, has shut down. Bob Fabbio, who was founder and CEO, said the closure was the result of "an unexpected situation." Fabbio is a well-known tech entrepreneur who co-founded Tivoli Systems.
- Cognite, a Norwegian industrial IoT software company, has selected both Austin and Houston as co-US headquarters.
- Apple announces new iphone and device recycling lab in Austin
- North Austin's <u>explosive growth</u> shifting business' attention away from downtown
- Austin Energy buys biomass plant for \$460M
- **JASK**, which develops security information and event management (SIEM) tools, has more than <u>doubled its headcount</u> in the last year, and is seeing rapid growth in its business, and now has more than 100 employees.
- As some big cities lose residents, Austin is adding them faster than anywhere else
- Austin-based Forcepoint to bring 300-plus jobs to new Boston facility
- Office rents in Central Texas reached an <u>all-time high</u> in the first quarter as the market continued on its upswing. Rents for top-tier office space averaged \$41.83 per square foot per year
