Austin Financing Activity

- Kony, a mobile app development platform with offices in Foster City and Austin, raised \$26.8M in funding from ORIX Growth
 Capital. The company has raised over \$150M to date from investors including SoftBank and Insight Venture Partners.
- ScaleFactor, a smart finance and accounting platform that enables businesses to operate in real-time, <u>raised</u> a \$10M Series A led
 by Canaan Partners with participation from investors including Citi Ventures and Next Coast Ventures.
- <u>Smarter Sorting</u>, a software provider to sort hazardous household waste, closed on another \$4.1M, bringing the total seed funding raised to \$8.3M from investors including **RTP Ventures**.
- RF Code, a data center monitoring and asset management platform, \$6.6M of venture funding from undisclosed investors. The
 company has raised approximately \$59M to date from investors including Intel Capital.
