Austin Financing Activity

- <u>Restaurant365</u>, a restaurant management platform based in Irvine-CA but with a major office in Austin, <u>raised</u> an \$88M Series C led by **ICONIQ Capital**
- Everyware, a central communications platform for two-way text messaging enabling more efficient customer service, raised <u>\$1.4M</u> from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Real AI</u>, who provides solutions to help multifamily investors find, evaluate and win more deals by leveraging AI and data analytics, raised an \$840k Seed Round.
- <u>Outbound Engine</u>, a marketing platform, <u>received</u> an \$8M venture loan from **Horizon Technology Finance**. The company has raised approx. \$30M in equity to date from investors including **S3 Ventures** and **Silverton Partners**.

Austin M&A Activity

 <u>Reachforce</u>, a software and data services provider designed to aid data completeness problems in real-time, was <u>acquired</u> by Leadspace, a B2B customer data platform, for an undisclosed amount. Reachforce had raised approx. \$15M from investors including Tribeca Venture Partners, MK Capital, and G-51 Capital.

Other Regional Deal Activity

- Epsilon Data Management, an Irving-based provider of data-driven marketing technologies and services, and subsidiary of Alliance Data Systems (NYSE: ADS), was <u>acquired</u> by Publicis Group (PAR: PUB) for \$4.4B. Epsilon was acquired by ADS for \$300M in 2004.
- **iHeartMedia**, the San Antonio-based global media company and biggest radio station owner in the country, <u>filed</u> for a direct listing on NASDAQ. Previously, the company had filed with Goldman Sachs and Morgan Stanley as underwriters. Now, the firm backed by Franklin Mutual, PIMCO, and Oppenheimer Funds has withdrawn the prospectus in favor of a directing listing.

- Sirius Computer Solutions, the San Antonio-based provider of information technology infrastructure and data center-focused technology integration services, was <u>acquired</u> by Clayton, Dubilier & Rice for an undisclosed sum. Previously, the company was acquired by Kelso & Company through a \$830M LBO in 2015.
- <u>HerdX</u>, a Boerne, TX-based provider of an ecosystem intended to help track and manage herd animals, <u>raised</u> \$5.9M of angel funding from undisclosed investors. The company has raised approx. \$14M to date.
- Modern Systems, a Dallas-based leader in application modernization, was <u>acquired</u> by **Advanced**, the UK's third largest software and services company, via its financial sponsor **Vista Equity Partners**.

• AffiniPay, a provider of merchant account and online payment gateway services, <u>named</u> Christian Fadel, who was previously CFO of Hyperwallet (acquired by PayPal), as CFO, and Greg Kattawar, previously a co-founder at Swivel and Spiceworks, will lead the engineering team. The company named Tom West as CEO in June, and last raised an undisclosed amount from PE firm Great Hill Partners in 2015.
