Austin Weekly Deal Highlights

Buy the dip or hedge for a strong market correction? With a presidential election right around the corner in the midst of a global pandemic, only thing that can be certain this time of year is getting pumpkin spice in your latte. All 3 major public market indexes were down this week: DJIA -1.7%; S&P 500 -2.5%, Nasdaq -4.1%. The Nasdaq Composite, which heavily weights tech stocks, is down 10% from its September 2nd highs, marking the fastest-ever fall from a record into the valley of correction. On the flip side, private market activity in Austin continues to be strong, with over \$35M in VC raised this week.

Austin Financing Activity

- <u>Sana Benefits</u>, an Austin-based provider of self-funded health insurance for small businesses, raised \$20.8 million in Series A funding. **Gigafund** led the round and was joined by investors including **Trust Ventures** and **mark vc**.
- <u>Decent</u>, a provider of health plans for small businesses and self-employed professionals,
 <u>raised</u> \$10M in Series A funding led by **QED Investors**.
- Trashbots, a hands-on robotics platform aimed at the K-12 market, <u>raised</u> seed-stage investment. They recently <u>completed</u> the **Sputnik** accelerator, which provided its initial investment of \$100,000. The company is currently looking to complete its \$500,000 seed-stage round and has already signed on **John Berkowitz**, founder of Yodle and **Ojo Labs**, and Austin Ventures founder, **Joe Aragona**.
- <u>Microtransponder</u>, a developer of nerve stimulation-based therapies, raised <u>\$5.75M</u> of convertible debt financing from undisclosed investors.

Austin M&A Activity

 Cove Hill Partners acquired part of Vista Equity's stake in <u>SecureLink</u>, an Austin, Texasbased third-party remote access software company, for an undisclosed amount. Vista Equity will continue to be a minority owner in SecureLink. Austin-based PE firm Peak Rock Capital <u>acquired</u> specialty infusion provider, Paragon Ventures. Paragon Healthcare generates \$250 million in annual revenue and transaction details were not disclosed.

Other Relevant/Regional Deal Activity

- <u>Simon Property Group</u> (NYSE: **SPG**) and <u>Brookfield Property Partners</u> (Nasdaq: **BPY**) have tentatively agreed to acquire most of the retail operations of Plano-based <u>JCPenney</u>, as part of a deal that will help the bankrupt retailer avoid liquidation. The agreement values JCP at around \$1.75 billion, with lenders putting up \$300 million for both the company's distribution arm and ownership of 161 of its roughly 650 remaining stores. JCP also is in talks with Wells Fargo for \$2 billion in new financing.
- Katy-based <u>Academy Sports + Outdoors</u>, a KKR-backed sporting goods retailer, <u>filed for an IPO</u> that Renaissance Capital estimates could raise \$500 million. The company plans to list on the Nasdaq (ASO) with Credit Suisse as lead underwriter and reports \$120 million of net income on \$4.8 billion in revenue for the fiscal year ending Feb. 1, 2020.
- Texas Ventures <u>launched</u> a Special Purpose Acquisition Corp. this week, IPO'ing on NASDAQ, with the name of the company as **Industrial Tech Acquisitions**, **Inc** (NASDAQ: ITACU). They are interested in M&A for companies in the tech sector with an enterprise value between \$200-600M.
- Nanospectra Biosciences, Inc., a Houston-based medical device company pioneering a
 novel use of nanomedicine for selective thermal ablation, <u>raised</u> \$3M in a Series B-1 led by
 Sirtex Medical as a strategic investor with additional participation from existing and new
 investors.
- **ParkerGale Capital** <u>acquired</u> a majority stake in <u>SMA Technologies</u>, a Houston-based provider of workload automation software.
- Houston-based <u>Symplr Software</u>, a healthcare governance, risk and compliance software provider and portfolio company of <u>Clearlake Capital Group</u> and <u>Skyknight</u>, <u>acquired ComplyTrack</u>, a healthcare regulatory risk solution, from <u>Wolters Kluwer Legal & Regulatory U.S.</u>
- Austin-based **Tritium Partners** led a <u>\$33M Series B</u> funding for <u>Chairish</u>, a San Francisco-based online marketplace for home furnishings.
- <u>Us Dataworks</u>, a Sugar Land-based payment processing software intended to simplify all aspects of payment processing for banks and businesses, was acquired by **CheckAlt**, the nation's largest independent remittance processor, for an undisclosed amount.

Austin People

- Everlywell, a provider of at-home testing kits, named industry veteran Andy Page as its first president. Page was previously CEO of venture-backed health tech startup Caption Health. Page will report to CEO and founder Julia Cheek. Everlywell last raised a \$50M Series B from Goodwater Capital in April 2019.
- CEO, president <u>resign</u> from drugmaker **Savara** (NAS: SVRA). **Rob Neville** resigned as CEO and **Dr. Taneli Jouhikainen** resigned as president and chief business officer, effective immediately.
- Austin-based threat-tech company <u>AlertMedia</u>, just <u>hired</u> former CNN executive, **Sara** Pratley to be the company's vice president of global intelligence. AlertMedia has raised

over \$55M to date from investors including **JMI Equity, Silverton Partners**, and **Next Coast Ventures**.

- Nobel Prize winner and University of Texas physicist, Steve Weinberg, will receive the 2020 Special Breakthrough Prize in Fundamental Physics for his leadership in fundamental physics. The award includes a \$3 million prize.
- <u>Swift Sensors Inc.</u>, a developer of IoT wireless sensors for the industrial industry has named **Ray Almgren** as CEO. He joined Swift Sensors as chief marketing officer in June 2016.
- Seasoned restaurant operator Dan Smith has <u>taken over</u> as CEO at tex-mex chain Trudy's
 after private equity firm Hargett Hunter purchased the Austin-based restaurant chain out
 of bankruptcy.
- The top Austin tech and startup executive hires and layoffs (August 2020)

Austin News

- The Young Women's Alliance and Young Men's Business League announced their <u>Austin Under 40 Awards</u>. Congrats to two entrepreneurs from the LiveOak family – Ben Rubenstein for winning Austinite of the Year, and John Berkowitz for winning the Real Estate category.
- <u>Eight Austin billionaires</u> make a return to the Forbes 400 list, including Michael Dell, **Robert Smith** and **Brian Sheth** of Vista Equity, **Bert Beveridge** of Tito's Vodka, and new Austinite and VC investor **Jim Breyer.**
- The top venture capital funding rounds for Austin tech startups in August 2020
- Applications are <u>now open</u> for **Techstars Austin's 11th** program kicking off in January.
- Pandemic slows, but can't stop, growth of 'mega region' between Austin and San Antonio
- The Pflugerville Solar Project, a utility-scale solar farm will <u>power</u> 25,000 homes in Austin. Recurrent Energy is heading the project but Austin-based workforce management and hiring platform **RigUp** is doing the hiring, expecting to bring on 350 employees.
- Cybersecurity company CipherLoc to pay \$400K to former CEO as it cuts ties after investigation. The agreement comes after CipherLoc had accused the former executive of "misappropriating the company's trade secrets, depleting its monies and other assets, damaging the value of the company."
- The **University of Texas** identified three coronavirus clusters in West Campus.
- The City of Austin <u>announced</u> it is offering \$10 million Relief in a State of Emergency (RISE) 2.0 funds to Travis County residents affected by COVID-19.
