

## **Austin Financing Activity**

- <u>Einride</u> a Swedish company with a large <u>Austin presence</u>, who develops electric and autonomous freight trucks, <u>secured \$500M in financing</u>, including both a Series C equity raise and a debt facility. The equity was provided by **Polar Structure** and the debt was provided by **Barclays**.
- <u>Dabbson</u>, a decentralized home energy ecosystem, <u>raised \$75M of seed funding</u> from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Beamery</u>, talent engagement platform based in London and Austin, raised a <u>\$50M Series D</u> led by **Teachers' Venture Growth.** The company has raised \$228M to date.
- <a href="mailto:ngrok">ngrok</a>, a platform based in San Francisco and Austin that offers secure, scalable, frictionless access to web apps, <a href="mailto:raised a \$50M Series A">raised a \$50M Series A</a> led by Lightspeed Venture Partners. ## **Austin M&A Activity**


<u>CognitiveScale</u>,an AI engineering platform, <u>has been acquired</u> by <u>Tecnotree</u> (HEL: TEM1V), a
market leader in 5G digital Business Support Systems, for an undisclosed amount. The company
raised over \$100M from investors including <u>Intel Capital</u>, <u>M12</u>, <u>IBM</u> and <u>Norwest Venture</u>
Partners.

## Other Texas Deal Activity

- <u>Poppi</u>, a Dallas-based prebiotic soda intended to help improve gut health, raised <u>a \$25M Series B</u> led by **CAVU Consumer Partners.** The company has raised approx. \$53M to date.
- <u>Sol-Ark</u>, a Plano-based solar and energy storage technology firm, filed to go public on December 12, 2022.
- <u>Americas Technology Acquisition</u>, Dallas-based blank check acquisition company, <u>announced its</u> liquidation due to its inability to consummate a business combination by the specified date.
- Actuate Therapeutics, a Fort Worth-based biopharmaceutical company for cancer treatment, raised \$19.3M of Series C funding from undisclosed investors. The company has raisd approx. \$65M to date from investors including Sea Purity Investments, Bios Partners, and Kairos Ventures.
- <u>Insala</u>, a Richardson-based mentoring, coaching, and alumni management solution for global enterprise organizations, announced that **HEXA Global Ventures** will invest \$10M.
- <u>Legion Health</u>, a Carrollton-based mental health marketplace, raised \$7.1M of Seed Funding led by Root and Shoot Ventures, per Pitchbook.
- <u>Playgrounds</u>, a San Antonio-based blockchain data orchestration platform, raised \$1.6M of Seed funding from FinTech Collective and other undisclosed investors.
