And talking about sprung, how about **ProsperOps** with a massive \$72M raise! What's more impressive is the company had only raised an \$800k seed round prior...that has to be one of the biggest mark ups between rounds in TX history...

VW FWD is a Vela Wood initiative whose mission is to provide financial resources and volunteer hours to organizations and causes that support justice and equal rights for marginalized communities and to educate and provide opportunities for our employees to become agents of social change. Austin Deal Activity

- <u>ProsperOps</u>, an autonomous cloud cost optimization platform, raised \$72M of venture funding led by **H.I.G. Growth Partners.** Previously, the company had raised an \$800k seed round led by **Active Capital.**
- <u>Sending Labs</u>, a Web3 communications startup with a presence in Austin, <u>raised \$12.5M in seed funding</u> led by Insignia Venture Partners, MindWorks Capital and Signum Capital. Other firms in on the round included K3 Ventures, Lingfeng Innovation Fund, UpHonest Capital and Aipollo Investment.
- <u>Holium</u>, an operating system designed to focus on collaborative computing and community building, raised \$2.9M of seed funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Repair Pricer</u>, a propery repair estimate technology, reached a definitive agreement to be acquired by **InspectionGo** for an undisclosed amount.
 Previously the company raised approx. \$1.5M.
- Enspire, an employee engagement platform, was acquired by Empyrean Benefit Solutions, a subsidiary of Securian Financial, for an undisclosed amount.
- <u>Scylla</u>, a threat detection system, <u>raised \$500,000</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors. The company has now raised approx. \$5.7M.

Other Texas Deal Activity

- <u>Bivacor</u>, a Houston-based developer of an artificial heart-pumping device, <u>raised \$15M</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors. The company has now raised approx. \$48M.
- <u>Callbox Storage</u>, a Dallas-based storage and logistics platform, <u>raised</u>
 <u>\$6.8M</u> of venture from undisclosed investors. The company has raised approx. \$17M to date.

- <u>Accelerate Learning</u>, a Houston-based developer of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) curriculum products, was acquired by **Providence Equity Partners** for an undisclosed amount. The company was previously acquired by **The Carlyle Group**, **Quad Partners** and **Rice Management Company** in 2018 for an undisclosed amount.
- Siguler Guff and Halliburton Company <u>have launched</u> Houston-based <u>Envana Software Partners</u>, a provider of critical emissions management software-as-a-service solutions to track greenhouse gas emissions in the oil and gas industry. No financial terms were disclosed.

- **Favor**, the Austin-based delivery company owned by H-E-B LP, has a new CEO and a bunch of other fresh faces in its C-suite. <u>Keith Duncan</u> has replaced <u>Jag Bath</u> as chief executive. Duncan worked at Favor as chief revenue officer and in other positions between 2015 and 2021.
- Website builder Wix.com cutting 100 jobs in Austin
- Sputnik ATX VC, Austin-Based Venture Capital Fund, <u>Announces 11th</u> <u>Cohort</u>
- <u>RSVP</u> for Mentor Sessions and Workshops at **SXSW 2023**
- **Applied Materials**, a semiconductor tool maker who has a large presence in Austin, <u>expects \$250M sales hit</u> because of cyberattack at supplier
- Central Texas' burgeoning defense and aerospace sector is set to get another boost, as X-Bow, New Mexico-based builder of rocket motors and other technologies aims to invest \$25 million in a new manufacturing facility in Caldwell County.
