And as we're building a market leading, category transcending company, you're damn sure nobody is better for the job than our minority, female CEO. Our \$8.3M Series A is just one data point in that massive \$4.7B figure, but I know there are several other similar stories that are also being written, or earning their chance. - The Helper Bees, a digital insurance company for seniors and families, announced a \$12.8 Series
   <u>B round</u> led by Trust Ventures. The Helper Bees have now raised \$20.1M from investors
   including Silverton Partners, Northwestern Mutual Futures Ventures, and Congress Avenue
   Ventures.
- Flip, an NFT marketplace platform, announced a \$6.5M seed round led by Distributed Global and Chapter One. Other investors included CMS Holdings and Larry Cermak, VP of research at The Block.
- At Ease Rentals, a vacation rental platform for federal and military personnel, reported a \$1M venture round from three investors. To date, At Ease has raised \$1.4M.up

# **Austin M&A Activity**

- <u>Iris Healthcare</u>, a provider of advanced care planning solutions for tens of thousands of patients across the country, <u>was acquired</u> by **Aledade**, for an undisclosed amount. Iris had raised approx.
   \$8.85M from investors including **LiveOak Venture Partners**, **Hatteras Venture Partners**, and **Activate Venture Partners**.
- <u>Upland Software Inc</u>, a cloud-based enterprise work management software company, announced the <u>acquisition</u> of <u>Objectif Lune</u> Inc for \$29M in cash. Upland went public in 2014, and has a market capitalization of \$617M.

# **Other Texas Deal Activity**

- TPG, the Fort-Worth Based global investment firm with over \$100B in assets under management, raises \$1B in first big IPO of 2022. After pricing its IPO at a \$9B valuation, the company goes public, with a 30-year track record that includes investments in Uber and Spotify.
- <u>Car Capital</u>, a Grapevine-based regulatory technology provider for car dealerships, <u>announced</u> a \$6.2M investment from <u>Fortress Investment Group</u>, as well as closing on a \$150M, three-year, credit facility. Car Capital has raised \$190.4M to date, with other investors including FM Capital and Medalist Partners.
- <u>Ecommerce Brands</u>, a Houston-based e-commerce aggregator platform, <u>raised a \$40M round</u>, including \$10M in equity led by Bearing Ventures.
- <u>Civitech</u>, a San Antionio-based public benefit corporation building data tools for progressive candidates and causes, is closing a Series A round over \$10M led by **Higher Ground Labs**.
- <u>Dura Software</u>, a San Antonio based a San Antonio-based software company buying hyper-niche software products from owners who want an exit from the market, raised \$6M of venture funding from undisclosed investors. Previously, the company raised \$10M of Series A led by **Ozone** <u>Capital Management</u> in 2019.
- <u>RealTime Software Solutions</u>, a San Antonio-based clinical trial management software, <u>secured a</u> growth investment from LLR Partners.
- Onit, a Houston-based enterprise workflow solutions provider, announced the acquisition of SecureDocs under undisclosed terms. Onit has raised \$216.6M to date from investors including K1 Investment Management, Level Equity Management, and Austin Ventures.
- <u>CareAR</u>, a Plano-based augmented reality platform, <u>announced</u> the acquisition of **Magic Lens** under undisclosed terms. CareAR is owned by Xerox and has raised \$10M in a corporate funding

round from ServiceNow.

ZenBusiness has raised \$274.5M to date from investors including Oak HC/FT, Cathay Innovation, and Greycroft, while Fanuele was previously led strategy for Fallon and Havas.
- The Zebra, an insurance comparison company, announced the hiring of John Wojcik as CMO. The Zebra has raised \$256.5M to date from investors including Accel, Ballast Point Ventures, and Silverton Partners, while Wojcik was previously Executive Vice President of Marketing and Executive Consultant at NorthStar Partners.
- AlertMedia Inc, an emergency communications company, announced the hiring of Elizabeth
   Loucheur as COO. AlertMedia has raised \$57M to date from investors including ATX Venture
