Funding announcements were incredibly light this week. I wouldn't say it's the lack of activity, but rather a temporary pause in announcements as the **SVB** saga continues to dominate the headlines. Many who received financing actually held the funds in SVB accounts. The fallout here will continue to linger, as their will be likely ramification on valuations, venture debt commitments, and the overall banking industry, as it's been over a week since the FDIC took over the bank's assets, yet the government still hasn't found a buyer for SVB. Meanwhile, in related news, **UBS** has agreed to take over **Credit Suisse**, which European regulators were forced to step in and orchestrate a deal to prevent a crisis spilling over into the broader financial system akin to what we saw here in the US.

- <u>Solarcycle</u>, an Odessa, TX-based solar design tech-driven recycling platform, raised a <u>\$30M</u> <u>Series A</u> led by <u>Fifth Wall</u> and <u>HG Ventures</u>. <u>Prologis Ventures</u>, <u>Closed Loop Partners</u> and <u>Urban Innovation Fund</u> also participated in the round.

- Nanospectra, a Houston-based medical device company pioneering a patient-centric use of nanomedicine for selective thermal ablation, <u>raised \$6M</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Galen Data</u>, a Houston-based platform for medical device connectivity, visualization, analytics, raised <u>\$3.5M</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors. The company has raised approx. \$6.5M to date.
- <u>Livmor</u>, a Frisco-based developer of heart rate monitoring equipment, <u>was acquired</u> by **HeartBeam** (NAS: BEAT) for an undisclosed amount
