## **Austin Weekly Deal Highlights**

May 15th, 2022

This might be old news for some, but feels like Austin has a supply chain tech hub on our hands... This week, we saw freight logistics platform **Mothership** relocate their HQ to Austin along with the announcement of a \$76M Series B. This follows a ton of activity that has bubbled up more recently, including **Convey** who was acquired for \$255M 6 months ago, **SourceDay** raising a \$31.5M Series C in March, and freight brokerage platform **Arrive Logistics** raising \$300M a year ago. Shoot, I even had Austin-based shipping marketplace **uShip** drop off a washing machine at my house earlier today. Now I just need a healthcare platform to fix my broken back after pushing it up my ridiculously steep driveway...

#### **Austin Financing Activity**

- Elsewhere Partners, a growth stage VC firm investing in capital efficient B2B software businesses, announced the closing of its second fund, Elsewhere Partners II, L.P., with \$175 million in new capital. It also announced the promotion of Sloane Child and Nick Stoffregen to Principal, both of whom previously served as Vice Presidents for the firm.
- Mothership a short-haul, same-day freight logistics software startup has moved its headquarters to Austin, and \$76M Series B from WestCap, Benchmark, and Bow Capital
- BalkanID, an Al-powered Identity Governance and Administration (IGA) solution
- announced \$5.75 million in seed funding from Uncommon Capital, Afore Capital and Sure
   Ventures
- <u>Sudozi</u>, a spend optimization software provider, raised a <u>\$4.3 million seed round</u> led by <u>Pear VC</u> with participation from <u>S3 Ventures</u> and <u>Mischief</u>.
- Yotta Energy, a leader in intelligent energy storage technology for the rooftop commercial and industrial (C&I) market, has <u>raised an additional \$3.5 million</u>, including a strategic investment from inverter OEM partner <u>APsystems</u>, bringing its total Series A investment to \$16.5 million.

#### **Austin M&A Activity**

- InspireSemiconductor, a platform designed for high-performance machine learning and scientific
  computing, blockchain applications and Al solutions, reached a definitive agreement to acquire
  Greenfield Acquisition (TSX: GAC.P) through a reverse merger for an undisclosed amount. The
  company has raised approx. \$10M to date.
- <u>CLEAResult</u>, a provider of energy efficiency, energy transition and decarbonization solutions, <u>announced the acquisition</u> of **ChooseEV**, a provider of electric vehicle market awareness and education tools ClearResult was acquired by **TPG** in 2018.

#### **Other Texas Deal Activity**


- <u>CellWize</u>, a Southlake-based mobile network automation and orchestration platform, reached a
  definitive agreement to be acquired by Qualcomm (NAS: QCOM) for \$300 million. Qualcomm
  Ventures had previously invested in the company, along with other investors including Intel
  Capital, Sonae, Verizon, and Samsung. The company had previously raised \$56.5M (per
  Pitchbook).
- <u>WizeHire</u>, a Houston-based hiring service for small- and medium-sized (SMB) businesses, has
  raised \$30 million in a Series B funding round led by **Tiger Global** with participation from **Amplo**and **Mercury**. The tranche values the company at \$250 million post-money
- Ours, a Houston-based a telemental health startup focused on couples therapy, <u>raised \$5 million</u> in seed funding from TMV, Serena Ventures, Lakehouse Ventures, Collaborative Fund,
   GreyMatter and Andy Dunn.
- <u>HireLogic</u>, a Dallas-based hiring platform, raised <u>\$4 million of seed funding</u> from **Edward J**.
   **Zander**, **Mike Pehl**, and **Ann Fandozzi**
- Wink, a Plano-based biometric identification platform raised \$2.85 million of seed funding led by
   CerraCap Ventures and Carneros Bay Capital
- <u>Buff City Soap</u>, a Dallas-based Manufacturer of plant-based, handmade soaps, received an additional, undisclosed investment from **General Atlantic**.
- ProFrac, a Willow Park, Texas-based provider of hydraulic fracturing products and services, raised \$288m in its IPO. The company priced at \$18 (below \$21-\$24 range) and will list on the Nasdaq (PFHC).
- **Stoller**, a Houston-based agricultural chemicals maker owned by the foundation of its late founder, is on the block for upwards of \$1.5b (including debt), per Bloomberg.

#### **Austin News**

- NXP Semiconductors NV may significantly expand its manufacturing operations in Austin as companies rush to boost chipmaking capacity in the United States. The Netherlands-based semiconductor producer is considering adding to either of the two large campuses it already has in the Texas capital. The company could invest \$2.6 billion and create 750 to 800 jobs with an average annual salary of more than \$100,000. NXP Semiconductors has an enterprise value of \$47.8B
