Austin Financing Activity

- <u>Devolver Digital</u>, a gaming company famous for HotLine Miami and Fall Guys, went public on the AIM market of the London Stock Exchange and <u>raised \$261M</u> at a \$950M valuation.
- Yotta Energy, a modular energy storage and microgrid company, announced a \$13M Series A
 round, led by WIND Ventures. Yotta has now raised \$20M from investors including Doral EnergyTech Ventures, Riverstone Ventures, and EDP Ventures.
- <u>Braincheck</u>, a mobile cognitive health screening company, <u>raised a \$10M Series B</u> round, led by <u>Next Coast Ventures</u> and <u>S3 Ventures</u>. 
