Austin Financing Activity

- <u>Zippy</u>, a home loan application platform, raised \$15.6M venture funding from undisclosed investors, per Pitchbook. The company has raised \$18.7M to date.
- <u>Astro</u>, formerly Austin Software, a management platform for development teams in Latin America, <u>raised \$13M</u> Series A funding. **Greycroft** led the round and was joined by investors including <u>Obvious Ventures</u>.

- <u>Fractal EMS</u>, a turn-key energy storage controls solution, <u>raised \$10M</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Cerebri AI</u>, who provides AI-driven insights & actions delivered to you as "Answers-as-a-Service", raised \$8M from undisclosed investors, per Pitchbook. The company has raised approx. \$45M to date.
- <u>LoudCrowd</u>, a brand management platform, raised a \$5M Series A led by Santa Monicabased Mucker Capital and participation from <u>LiveOak Venture Partners</u> and <u>Active Capital</u>.
- Tokenproof, a token-gating system designed to prove ownership of clients' NFTs, raised \$5M seed round led by Penny Jar Capital. Corazon Capital, 6th Man Ventures, Canonical Crypto, and Mark Cuban also participated in the round.
- <u>tapNpay</u>, a payment technology designed to simplify the collection of tolls from untagged vehicles, raised \$1.5M of venture funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>BioDAF</u>, a wastewater treatment technology, <u>raised \$1.5M</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Purecode Software</u>, code generating software for web development, <u>raised \$1M</u> of angel funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Spearix</u>, a provider of wireless connectivity services intended for IoT applications, <u>raised</u> an undisclosed amount of venture funding from **Emerson Ventures**.

Austin M&A Activity

- Austin-based <u>CynergisTek</u> was <u>acquired</u> by <u>Clearwater</u> Compliance LLC, a healthcare focused cybersecurity, compliance, and risk management solutions firm, in an all cash transaction that valued CynergisTek at approximately \$17.7 million.
- Hyliion Holdings Corp., a Cedar Park-based trucking technology company, <u>agreed to acquire</u> a
 hydrogen and fuel agnostic generator from a division of **General Electric** (NYSE: GE) called **GE**Additive for \$37 million

Other Texas Deal Activity

- VRGL, a Dallas-based wealth management data analytics software, <u>raised a \$15M Series A</u> led by MissionOG and FINTOP Capital. Northwestern Mutual Future Ventures, Flyover Capital, Fin Capital, and 4 other investors also participated in the round.
- <u>BioAffinity Technologies</u>, a San Antonio-based company focused on noninvasive diagnosis of early-stage cancer, <u>raised \$7.86 million in its initial public offering</u> on the Nasdaq Stock Exchange under the ticker symbol of BIAF. The company has a market cap of \$28.3M as of 9/2/22.
- Asset Entities, a Dallas-based web 3.0 multi-media marketing company, filed to go public on the Nasdaq stock exchange under the ticker symbol of ASST, with the intention to raise up to \$17M.
- <u>Clockwork</u>, an Allen-based decentralized automation network for Solana, closed a <u>\$4M seed round</u> co-led by **Multicoin Capital** and **Asymmetric**.
- <u>Halo Collar</u>, a Plano developer of a pet application, smart collar, and virtual dog fence, <u>raised \$3M</u> of venture funding from undisclosed investors.
- <u>Prevailion</u>, The Woodlands-based predictive platform designed to analyze cyber defense and third-party risk, <u>raised \$1.8M</u> of convertible debt financing from undisclosed investors. The company has raised approx. \$19.5M to date.
